

### **Arrangements for members who wish or need to take a term out**

Currently members can leave and, by formal pre-arrangement with the Committee, return after one term, by joining the top of the waiting list, rejoining as soon as someone leaves the choir. Thereafter they would need to go to the bottom of the waiting list, like any new prospective member. No one can leave for a term or more and return without prior arrangement.

Anyone taking more than one term out would need to make a case to the Committee prior to leaving to be considered eligible for special treatment (e.g. in case of serious illness).

If the committee has not been kept informed of circumstances, the space will be filled with a new member and the returning, former member would need to join the bottom of the waiting list.
